#### A Lesson on Windows:

There has probably not been a more significant concept in the last 30 years in terms of spreading the gospel than the realization that most of the peoples of the world who have not heard the gospel live in the regions called the *10/40 Window*. This *window* is the rectangular area of North Africa, the Middle East, and Asia between 10 degrees North and 40 degrees North Latitude. The 10/40 Window includes the majority of the world's Muslims, Hindus, and Buddhists. Approximately five billion people out of the world population of 7.5 billion live in this window.

But there is another window which may be just as significant and that window is the *4/14 Window*. Studies have shown that 70% of those people who come to know Christ as their Savior do so between the ages of 4 and 14. So, if people are going to become a Christian, they are far more likely to make that decision by the age of 14 than after that age. At the very least, this confirms that children and young people are indeed the world's most fruitful field, and we cannot afford to neglect this window.

#### Talking about children ...

The 264,000 meals that we packed with the Feed My Starving Children event were shipped on April 9<sup>th</sup> to Swaziland in Southern Africa. The meals will be distributed through a Christian orphanage called The Children's Cup. They serve FMSC meals in their centers and church or partner sites that care for orphaned and vulnerable children. Thank you for your part in that!



## GATEKEEPERS Security Memo

#### **Locked Doors**

One of the responsibilities of our church leaders is to be Gatekeepers. As Gatekeepers, we have a dual role—like a shepherd we minister to the sheep, but we also provide for their protection. This has been a requirement even going back to Old Testament days. Please read Ezekiel 33:6.

HCA has been locking all exterior doors during school hours for a couple of years now. Here at HGC in the sanctuary building, we are locking the two exterior doors near the platform ten (10) minutes after each service starts and unlocking them when the service ends to allow access for those parking in the rear parking area.

The doors downstairs by the boiler room are always locked, and the lower entrance doors by the kindergarten are locked when the 5:00 pm service starts. You are always able to exit any of the doors simply by pushing the bar in the usual manner.

Your ability to worship in peace and safety is an important concern as we see this troubled world struggling without Christ. All the more reason for us to passionately seek . . .
